Description

Fourteen new runners showed up for co-ed varsity cross-country practice on September 9, bringing the team total to a sizable twenty-six. By the New England Championships at Brooks on November 9, this impressive group of harriers had covered hundreds of miles of back country roads, hiked — no, correct that — run up eight New Hampshire 4,000 footers, sweated through sixteen core and general strength workouts, participated in nine “variety days” featuring biking, roller skiing, cycling and ultimate frisbee, and endured ten interval workouts. Oh, and yes, they also ran in seven invitational races.

The girls once again won the Lakes Region Championships led by Joy Erdman (3rd) and newcomer Susie Griffin (4th). The boys lost a squeaker to Brewster Academy and demonstrated how much this team had developed by placing eight runners in the top 20 (105 runners total from 9 teams). Earning “All League” honors for the boys were Tyler Munroe, Zach Lahey, Bryce Connery, Austin Haynes, J.J. Hall, Malcolm Lewis, Nathan Winebaum, and Charlie Erdman. At the New England the boys placed eighth and the girls pulled off an outstanding third-place finish.
